

PARTNER IN FAITH FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Are my contributions tax-deductible?

Yes. Faith In Action Ministries, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) organization, which allows your contributions to be tax-deductible. However, you should still consult your tax advisor.

2. What are the duties of a Partner In Faith?

A Partner in Faith has many duties, all of which are important to the continued functioning and success of the Ministry.

A Partner in Faith must first be a prayer warrior and continue to be prayerful for the Ministry's leaders in serving individuals, families, and organizations that request our services.

A Partner in Faith is asked to publicly use or wear any membership gifts and be prepared to answer any questions regarding the Ministry and its business. Therefore, a Partner in Faith should be knowledgeable about the Ministry's mission statement, goals, and services, as well as our Statement of Faith.

A Partner in Faith is encouraged to share information about the Ministry to others in the hope that others, too, will decide to become Partners in Faith. A Partner in Faith should also carry Ministry business cards or brochures to give to those whom you speak to about the Ministry.

3. Are there different levels of membership?

No. At this time, there are not any different levels of membership.

4. Can I give a lump sum and still be a Partner in Faith?

Yes. You can give either monthly or annually. You have the option on the Partner in Faith Application to indicate how much and when you will contribute to the Ministry.

5. Will I be rewarded for becoming a Partner in Faith with this Ministry?

Yes. You will be rewarded for becoming a Partner in Faith with this Ministry, but not in the way you may think. God rewards those who contribute to the fulfillment of His service. You will reap the spiritual rewards of knowing that your contribution is being used to help someone who is in need of emotional, physical, or spiritual help, which will be met through this Ministry. Spiritual rewards include joy in knowing you are of service to someone who needs help, the joy that comes with selfless giving, and the assurance that God will bless you for your sacrifice.
